Homework for March 5

We did a little review of autonomous forms in the fall, and it is time to circle back. We see these forms in our reading, but we don't use them much, so we need to pay them a little extra attention.

Rewrite each of the sentences below, replacing the (first) *verb + subject* with the autonomous form of the same tense. If the sentence is in the negative, write the new one in the negative. You may have to add a word or two, e.g., if the subject is "people of Dingle", you might end up saying something "is done in Dingle".

So if you see: Níor bhris sí na fuinneoga.

You would write: Níor briseadh na fuinneoga.

Be careful that you don't end up using a subject with your autonomous forms!
