

Sample Dictionary Entries

The sample entries below show you the definitions offered by three portable dictionaries -- the Oxford Pocket, the Collins Gem, and the Foclóir Scoile -- to some common words. Note that the Foclóir Póca provides exactly the same information as the Foclóir Scoile, but in an even more portable, but harder to read, format.

For comparison, we chose the words *right/ceart* and *minute/nóiméad*, because the treatment of the homonyms represented by the English entries is helpful in evaluating their comprehensiveness.

Naturally, the desktop dictionaries provide much more comprehensive treatment of these concepts. And there are other portable dictionaries available. This supplement to the article in the Lúnasa, 2009 edition of *An Gaeilgeoir* simply gives you more information about three of the most useful of the portable Irish-English dictionaries.

ceart and *nóiméad*
